

California State Service Rifle Championship and CMP Leg Match

Sponsored by the California Rifle and Pistol Association

Hosted by Coalinga Rifle Club Inc.

April 3,4&5, 2009

Location: Coalinga Rifle Range, Derrick Blvd. ¾ mile north of Jayne Ave., Coalinga, CA.

Food: A BBQ will be served after firing Saturday. Free to all paid competitors. Juniors and all others will be charged \$10.

Entries: ADVANCE ENTRY IS REQUIRED. All entries must be accompanied by full payment on the enclosed entry form. Entries will be accepted to the capacity of the range and will close April 1, 2009. A \$10 fee will be charged for all post entries. *In the past* I have not enforced the late entry fee. But because of the need for an accurate head count for the BBQ, the late entry fee will be in full effect this year. SO BE FOREWARNED.

Eligibility: National Rifle Association membership is required. CRPA membership is required for all competitors who participate in a CRPA State Championship. Membership applications will be available at the range before the match. Non-California residents who show proof of current membership in an NRA-affiliated *State Association* or an NRA-approved *Foreign Shooting Federation* are eligible for a State Championship Membership. The fee for Junior Membership and State Champion Membership is \$5. For competitors who do not meet these requirements, the fee for annual CRPA membership is \$22.

Match Fees: State Championship, \$60; Juniors shoot free--\$30 fee paid by CRPA
Friday Team Match, \$40 per team
CMP Excellence in Competition Match, \$20; Juniors \$10
There will be an individual match run concurrently with the EIC match \$20

Rules: This is an NRA Registered match and NRA High Power rules will apply. It is the competitor's responsibility to be familiar with the current rules. Rule 11.6.7 will not be in effect. Empty chamber indicators are required.

Classification: The NRA classification system will be used in all matches.

Sharing Equipment? If two competitors wish to use the same equipment, their entry forms must be so noted. An attempt will be made to accommodate them.

Scoring/Target Service: Competitors will score and pull targets. Any competitor who does not fulfill his or her scoring or target pulling duties may be disqualified.

Targets: All firing will be on appropriate NRA targets.

Squadding: All matches will be squadded.

Pins: Each competitor will receive a CRPA souvenir pin.

Firing Schedule

Four person Team Match. Friday April 3 Squadding 0800.

NMC of fire (50 shot) with sighters. Block time will be used for the slow fire stages. **There will be teams formed at the range for all competitors who do not have a team.**

California State Service Rifle Championship Squadding 0700 Saturday, April 4

Match # 1 200 yards two sighters and 20 shots for record from the standing position in 22 minutes.

Match # 2 200 yards two sighters in two minutes. Two strings of 10 shots sitting in 60 seconds.

Match # 3 300 yards two sighters in two minutes. Two strings of 10 shots prone in 70 seconds.

Match # 4 600 yards two sighters and 20 shots for record in a time limit of 22 minutes from the prone position.

Match # 5 Rapid Fire Aggregate of matches 2 & 3.

Match # 6 Slow Fire Aggregate of matches 1 & 4.

California State Service Rifle Championship: Aggregate of matches 5 & 6.

CMP "Leg" Match Squadding 0700 Sunday, April 5

National Match Course, no sighter shots allowed.

Stage 1 200 yards, slow fire standing, 10 record shots, 10 minute time limit.

Stage 2 200 yards, rapid fire sitting/kneeling from standing, 10 record shots, 60-second time limit.

Stage 3 300 yards, rapid fire prone from standing, 10 record shots, 70-second time limit.

Stage 4 600 yards, slow fire prone, 20 record shots, 20-minute time limit.

Awards: There will be an awards presentation Saturday afternoon following the Championship Match. Awards will consist of cash. The California State Service Rifle Champion will receive the California Bear Trophy in addition to cash. CMP "Leg" Match awards are mailed by the Civilian Marksmanship Program.

Award Restrictions: A competitor may not win more than one award in any one match, other than a special award. There must be at least three competitors in each class/category for a first place award, seven for second place award, eleven for a third place award and fifteen for a fourth place award. In the event that there are fewer than three competitors in a class, they will be combined with the next higher class.

National High Power Rifle Team Selections: "Membership on CRPA teams selected for national competition shall be determined by order of finish in the most recent state championship aggregate in that discipline from those competitors who are both a resident of California and a current CRPA member in good standing prior to the beginning of competition. A person accepting a position on a CRPA team agrees to abide by NRA and CRPA rules and any reasonable instructions from the team captain. Failure to comply may result in forfeiture of funding and debarment from participation in CRPA sanctioned activities for up to five years. Such disciplinary action may be imposed after a hearing by the Executive Council upon receipt of a written complaint filed by the Chairman of the High Power Rifle Committee."
